## Sparkling & Champagne

23. **Prosecco, Italy NV** £5.95  
This quarter bottle provides a flute and a half  
**One4One, Italy NV (200ml)**  
This fully sparkling wine offers a bouquet of pear drops, lemon and melon. The palate is light and fresh with a clean finish.
24. **Prosecco, Botter, Italy NV** £19.50  
This fully-sparkling wine is pale yellow gold in colour and offers a bouquet of pear drops, lemon and melon. The palate is light and fresh leaving you with a clean finish.
25. **Pinot Grigio Rosé Spumanté, Mirabello, Italy NV** £17.50  
A lively rosé fizz with delicate aromas of red berries & a palate of lush, summer fruits.
26. **Champagne Gremillet Brut Selection, France NV** £39.95  
A fine mousse in the glass and creamy aromas mixed with toasty yeast overtones. This is complemented by ripe mature fruit and classic baked biscuit flavours with classy long finish.

## Port

### Colheita Vintage Port Krohn & Weise Portugal

These ports, best described as a tawny port from a single vintage, the wines have all the nuances of an aged tawny whilst expressing the characteristics of a single vintage. By law, Colheita ports must be aged in wood for 7 years. In practice Krohn often age their wines much longer, to develop extra richness and intensity.

27. **1997/8 vintage** 50ml glass £3.90  
Ruby to brick red colour, orange at the rim. Spirity nose, with notes of caramel and raisins whilst the palate delivers orange peel and mulled spices. A long, sweet, intense finish. Try it with nuts, blue cheese and all types of berries.

## Dessert Wine

28. **Monbazillac, Ancienne Cure** Half bottle £15.95  
**France 2010** 50ml glass £3.10  
This Monbazillac is absolutely stunning with flavours of marzipan, orange peel, flowers and spices with a refreshing and light "runny honey" texture.

### fresh.dry.white

Light, fruity and crisp; these wines are easy to drink with a clean finish. Perfect with grilled fish, salads and chicken.

1. **Pinot Grigio, Garganega, Italy 2012** £2.90 £3.55 £4.60 £11.95  
It has an intense straw colour and also an ample, lasting fruity bouquet. The palate is dry, soft and well balanced.
2. **Sauvignon Blanc, Volandas 2012** £2.99 £3.95 £5.15 £12.95  
Fresh, lively Sauvignon Blanc with zesty citrus notes and a hint of gooseberry fruit on the finish.
3. **PicPoul de Pinet, Domaine de Montredon** £22.95  
Beautiful floral display on the nose. Great balance in the mouth with a beautiful acidity. A stunning finish that leaves you wanting more. Fabulous with shell fish!

### aromatic.fruity.white

Fresh with a distinctive nose, these wines have good fruit and crisp acidity. Will match well with shellfish, goats cheese and spicy dishes.

4. **Chenin Blanc, Kleindal, South Africa** £2.90 £3.55 £4.60 £12.25  
A fresh, lively Chenin Blanc with crisp apple flavours on the palate and a touch of honey. The finish is off-dry with good balancing acidity.
5. **Dart Valley Reserve, Sharpham Estate, Devon 2010** £19.95  
This dry and ever popular wine has a light, fresh character achieved by careful blending of the Madeleine Angevine, Phoenix and Kernling grapes and partial ageing in American oak. Lovely fruit aromas with supple, delicate flavours and a just off-dry style resulting in a wine ideal
6. **Viognier, Montevista Chile 2011** £20.95  
Bright, vibrant and expressive with a touch of fresh pear fruit. Wonderfully pure, lifted and aromatic with a long, textural finish.

### unoaked.medium-bodied.white

Packed full of fruit with a smooth, mouth-filling texture. These wines are delicious with light, creamy pasta dishes, salmon, pork and roast chicken.

7. **Chardonnay, Peregrino, Chile 2011** £2.90 £3.55 £4.60 £11.95  
Made from 100% Chardonnay, it has a pale straw colour, and fruity aromas of apple and papaya with hints of pineapple. It is a rounded and fulfilling wine well structured with hint of sweetness on the finish.
8. **Chablis, Elegance, Burgundy 2010** £25.25  
Full, powerful, and mineral on the palate with flavours of citrus zest. Harmonious balance between concentration of fruit, and freshness.

### Rosé Wines

#### juicy.ripe.rosé

Ripe-berry flavours and summer fruits abound in this popular style of rosé. Best as a chilled aperitif or with some spicier dishes.

9. **Zinfandel Rosé, Wildwood, US 2011**    £3.05   £4.10   £5.05   £12.95  
Ripe juicy grapes produce this delightful wine with aromas of fresh strawberries and soft red fruits. Mouth-watering summer berry flavours with a hint of candy create this perfectly balanced refreshing rose.

#### fruity.dry.rosé

Delicate fruit with a crisp, clean finish. These rosés are elegant and refined. Perfect with light dishes such as salads and grilled fish or as an aperitif.

10. **Rioja Rosé, Monesterio, Spain 2011**                      £13.95  
Gamacha based Rosado Rioja with fresh berry fruit aromas and a youthful energy and appeal. Cherry red in colour, it stands out for its fresh, fruity aroma.

### Red Wines

#### light.juicy.red

Light-bodied and elegant, these wines are a favourite in the warmer months, when they can be served chilled, but are versatile enough to be enjoyed anytime of the year. Fabulous on their own or paired with simple dishes such as pasta, grilled fish or chicken.

12. **Pinot Noir, Duette, Casablanca Valley Chile 2010**                      £21.25  
On the nose it has abundant, ripe, red fruit with floral notes. On the palate it has a soft, delicate texture with the lively acidity that is typical of Pinot Noir.
11. **Fleurie, La Madone, Beaujolais France 2011**                      £21.95  
Ripe red fruit flavours with notes of strawberry and morello cherries. A subtle grip on the finish. An extremely versatile wine—will go with spicy dishes or with gamey meat dishes.

#### medium.smooth.red

Fruity and medium-bodied, these wines are easy to drink and very versatile with smooth, mellow tannins and plenty of flavour. Great with a wide range of foods including pasta and grilled meats.

13. **Merlot, Los Espinos, Chile 2011**                      £2.90   £3.55   £4.60   £12.95  
Juicy red fruit packed with subtle bramble & blackberries. Fresh & elegant on the palate with a beautifully delicate structure.
14. **Sangiovese, Cortestrada Italy 2011**    £2.90   £3.55   £4.60   £12.95  
A terrific easy drinking red with aromas of red berry and damson fruit. Fresh and lively on the palate with juicy berry fruit and a hint of spice.
15. **Valpolicella, Montesor, Veneto Italy 2010/11**                      £16.25  
A medium bodied red with lively aromas of cherries, violets and almonds and a hint of the mossy/herbaceous character typical of Valpolicella. Soft, velvety palate showing a touch of sour cherry and light background oak.
16. **St Emilion, Château Negrit, Bordeaux France 2010**                      £20.95  
A velvety soft Bordeaux with subtle plum fruit on the palate with a touch of underlying dark cherry. Great structure and a fine, elegant finish.

#### rich.warming.red

Full-bodied and spicy, these wines are big and bold. Perfect in the cooler months, they work well with substantial dishes such as roast meats, game and rich tomato sauces.

17. **Shiraz, Wildwood, USA 2010**                      £2.90   £3.55   £4.60   £12.50  
Soft blackcurrant fruit with minty flavours and hints of spice and leather abound in this Shiraz. Deep intense & sumptuous - rich full Californian style but not too heavy, just loads of fruit & flavour.
18. **Cabernet Sauvignon, Peregrino, Chile**    £2.90   £3.55   £4.60   £11.95  
This brilliant ruby red wine is full flavoured with notes of cassis and chocolate aromas. It is medium-bodied and will go well with red meat, lamb, pasta and cheese.
19. **Malbec Reserva, Nieto, Argentina 2010**                      £19.95  
Deep ruby colour. Complex nose of damsons, nuts and dried fruits. Full bodied on the palate with rounded, ripe tannins and a long finish reminiscent of plums, damsons and figs.

20. **Shiraz, Vat 8 De Bortoli, Australia 2008**                      £20.50  
Deep purple hues in appearance. Aromas of ripe berry fruit and cedar wood are lovely and intense. This is a generously flavoured Shiraz with a palate of ripe red berry and black fruit characters softened and balanced by cedary oak and firm tannins.

#### oaked.mature.red

The sensitive use of oak-ageing adds texture and a smoky, mellow note to these full-bodied wines. Soft and velvety on the palate, they pair very well with rich sauces, red meat and strong cheeses.

21. **Rioja Reserva, Ontanon Spain 2004**                      £29.50  
Deep, dark fruit flavours combined with ample acidity, minerality and earthy notes. It has a fine structure and natural grape tannins to give good length and weight.
22. **Barolo, Patrizi, Italy 2006**                      £37.95  
Heady mature wine with a smoky nose with aromas of dried fruit, leather and earthy woodiness: quite rich and rustic: velvety and rounded but finishing with a characteristic austerity, dry grip and bite of acidity.
